7. DEAN'S REPORT

Dr. Hemmelgarn has been reaching out to Departments and requesting to meet with various Departments virtually and would like to meet with more Faculty and staff members.

Budget and Strategic Planning update:

Li-Kwong Cheah provided update:

- Has been meeting Faculty members.
- Reviewed the campus Alberta grant – 2yr cut of 17.6% = \$110million over two years.
- Reviewed impact on the FoMD – Net Cut Base Budget – 10.7%
- Each faculty has to absorb their own merit and COLA.
- Need to find savings/revenue of approximately \$12million dollars in the next fiscal year.
- Spoke to the Uniform Survey.
- Reviewed costs of operations.

Dr. B. Hemmelgarn presented her report:

- University of Alberta at the institutional level is taking two approaches –the formulation of the Academic Restructuring Working Group – looking at the structure of the University overall. Thank you to Dr. D. Eisenstat for representing the FoMD Department Chairs on this committee. The second working group formed is the Service Excellence Transformation – this is using the uniform data with the external consultant the NOUS group, which is looking at administrative restructuring and areas of efficiency that can be added at an institutional level.
- Within the FoMD it is absolutely critical that we fulfil our academic mission. Need to maintain the excellence in education, research and clinical care to ensure that we have long term success – this is foundational.
- Looking at a staged approach.
- Faculty Budget Working Group has been formed – with a broad range of representation. Meets weekly. Have contracted with the NOUS Group. Will be focusing on the three key areas for cost efficiency improvement: Efficiencies in administrative services; Optimizing non-labor costs; and Enhancement of delivery methods.
- Need to look at increasing revenue and reduction in expenses.
- Starting a Strategic Planning process – will start in June and will be seeking input from Faculty and Staff, implementation for the Fall of 2020.
- Will be looking for options for shared services.

FEC Standards Update

Awarding of Tenure and Rank of Associate Professor

“For the award of tenure, the Academic Faculty member must demonstrate a strong record of achievement in teaching and research, and must demonstrate on the basis of performance while on probation that he/she is capable of contributing effectively as a staff member in all areas of responsibility” (A6.03.3 (c))

- The promotion of an Academic Faculty member and the award of tenure shall be decided by FEC following review of the Academic Faculty member’s performance over the complete career. (A6.12.1) (Clarification from Faculty relations: performance during the probationary period is the most important factor. Example: someone who had a great record prior to coming to the U of A but does little during probation should not be granted tenure on the basis of pre probationary performance.)

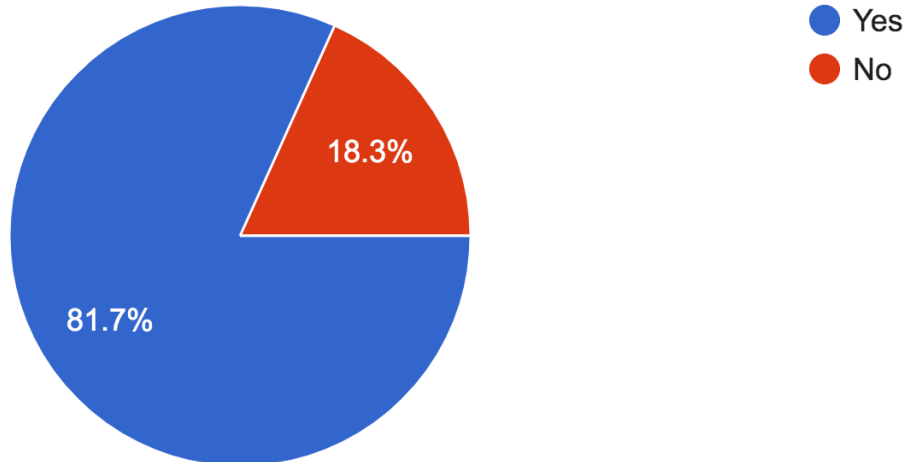

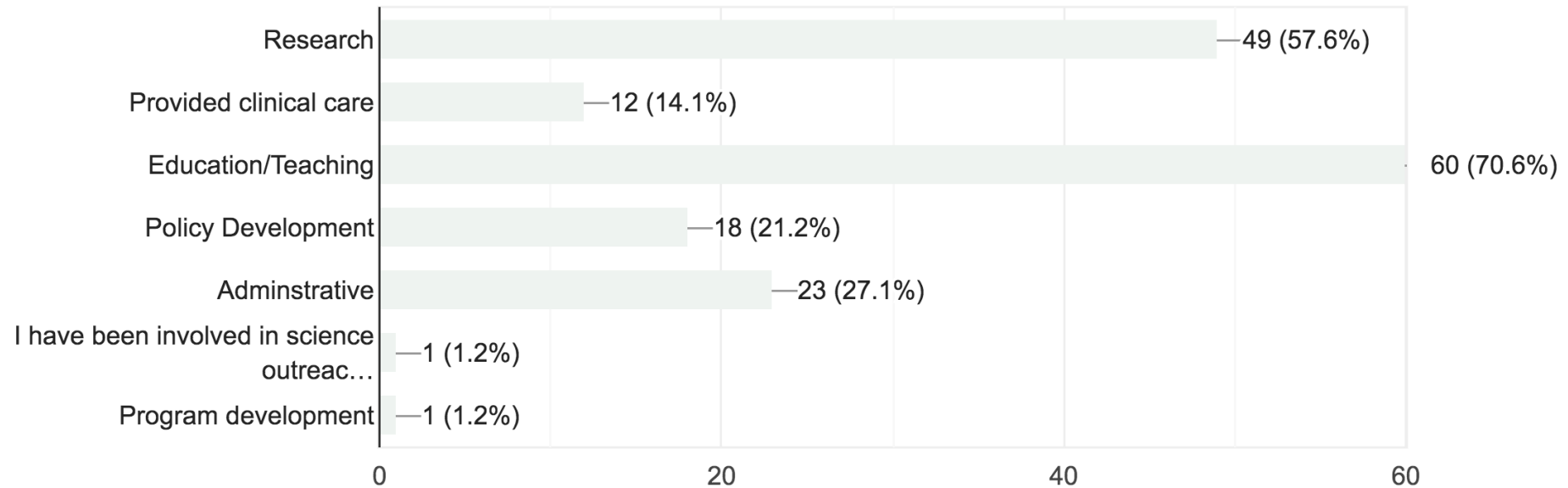
In the last 5 years, have you participated in international engagement activities - these could be activities done at an international site, or locally with an international audience?

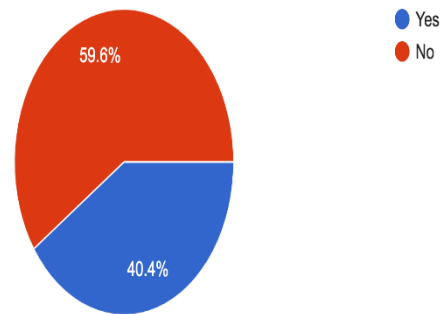

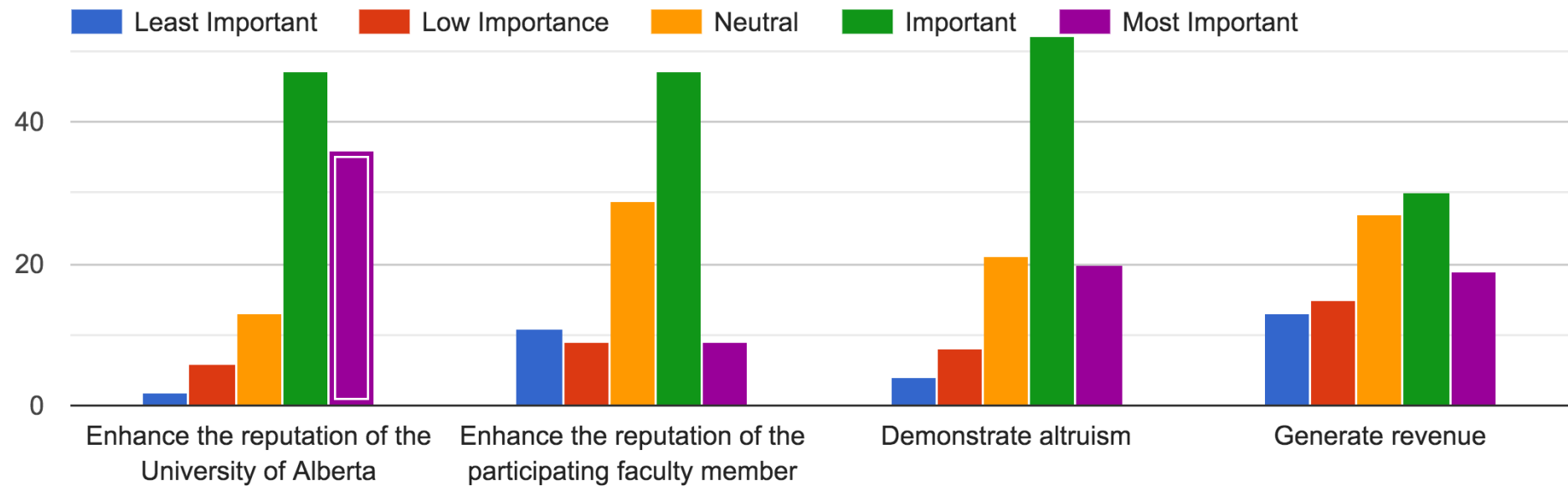

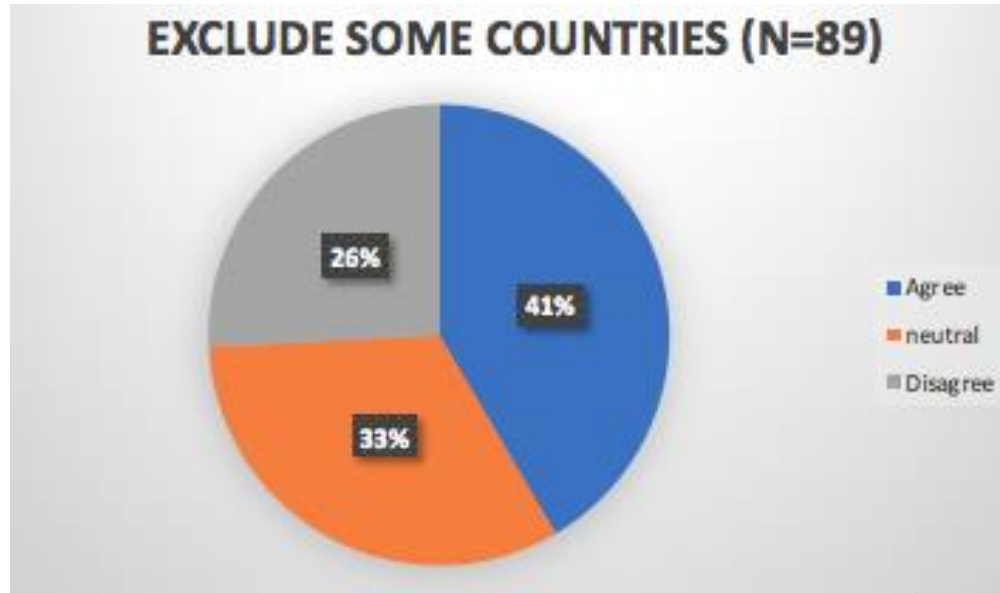

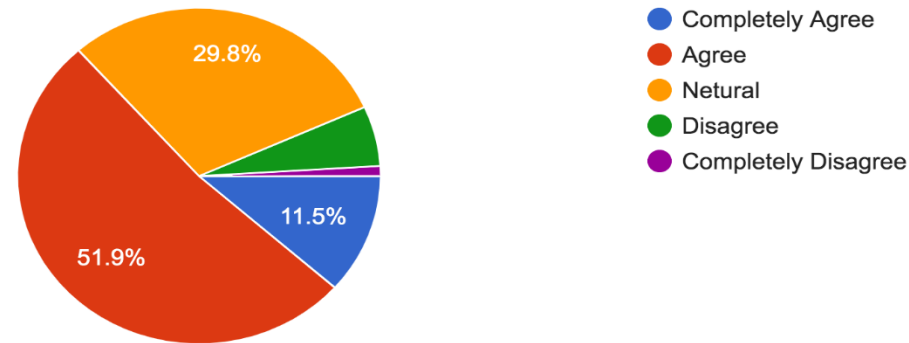
