1. CALL TO ORDER

Dr. R. Fedorak called the meeting to order at 4:00 pm and welcomed everyone to the Faculty Council meeting, September 20, 2016.

6. DEAN'S REPORT

a. President's Visiting Committee

Dr. Richard Fedorak gave an update on the President's Visiting Committee. This Committee was put together by the President of the University of Alberta, represented by 4 past Deans from Canada, the Deputy Minister, Vice President of Stantec and 4 scientists who looked at our Faculty and the question posed to them was: "What does it take to move us in Research to the next level?" There were 18 different recommendations. These have been looked at by the Dean's Executive Committee, Department Chairs and 50-60 people that had participated in PVC and Faculty Leadership. A draft response was prepared which will go on line shortly in our intranet. As soon as the recommendations have been finalized, along with the President, this will be presented to the Board of Governors on Friday, December 16, 2016. This is the opportunity to show them who we are, what we are but require some investment to get there.

 b. Precision Medicine / Precision Public Health Initiative
Dr. Richard Fedorak presented Precision Medicine / Precision Public Health Initiative. He discussed Alberta's Precision Health Initiative, Alberta's
Opportunity, Alberta's Precision Health Platform and a Value-Guided Translation: Mapping out UA/AB Assets. The presentation is attached:

d. Leadership - Gold College

To go forward in 2020, Leadership will be key in moving this faculty forward. A Gold College cohort will be established for us. There will be a Chairs Leadership Series as well as a Faculty Leadership Series starting in January, 2017.

7. NEW BUSINESS:

a. MD Admissions

Dr. Fedorak reported that the MD Admissions process has not been reviewed for 10 years, therefore, he initiated an internal review process. This is being presented again to Faculty Council with a desire to move further. Tracy Hillier and Sita Gourishankar presented the following slides:

THAT Faculty Council **entrust** the Assistant Dean Admissions and the Admissions Committee to implement processes and procedures to improve equity and diversity in the MD program and better serve the people of Alberta.

MOVED by Dr. Fraser Brenneis and SECONDED by Dr. Barbara Ballermann to approve the MD Admissions presentation. **CARRIED**

Discussion followed regarding:

- Recommendation #6 "Indigenous applicants should not be treated differently or have additional requirements for admission beyond declaring eligibility". Re-wording the recommendation was suggested to read: Indigenous applicants should **not have additional requirements** or barriers for admission.
- Include Develop and Implement throughout the chart.

Revised motion should read:

THAT Faculty Council **entrust** the Assistant Dean Admissions and the Admissions Committee to implement processes and procedures to improve equity and diversity in the MD program and better serve the people of Alberta, by assessing and developing the recommendations made by the Admissions Review Committee.

Dr. Fraser Brenneis accepted the Amendment to the Motion and Dr. Barbara Ballerman seconded. **CARRIED**
